

arteries

blood vessels that carry blood from the heart to the body

capillary

the smallest blood vessel; gases nutrients, and wastes are exchanged between capillaries and cells

circulatory

of or relating to circulation or to the circulatory system

dialysis

a medical treatment that carries out the same processes as the human kidney

egg

a germ cell produced by a female -- called also ovum

<p>egg</p>	<p>the first stage of an animal's life cycle</p>
<p>gland</p>	<p>a group of cells that can filter blood and/or produce substances that assist in various bodily processes</p>
<p>heart</p>	<p>a muscular organ that pumps blood</p>
<p>kidney</p>	<p>a bean-shaped organ that filters water and waste materials out of the blood</p>
<p>ovary</p>	<p>one of the usually paired organs in the body of female animals that produces eggs and that in female vertebrates also produces sex hormones</p>

of, relating to, or capable of  
reproduction

ureter

a thick-walled tube that carries urine  
from the kidney to the bladder

urethra

a tube that carries urine from the  
bladder to the outside of the body

urinary

of, relating to, or used for urine

urination

the process of releasing urine from the  
bladder and out of the body through the  
urethra

urine

a fluid consisting of body waste and  
excess water

vascular

containing vessels that transport water  
and other fluids

vein

a blood vessel that transports blood back  
to the heart

ventricle

one of the two lower chambers of the  
heart
