

centimeter

a metric unit used to measure length
(100 centimeters = 1 meter)

cup

a customary unit used to measure liquid
capacity; 2 cups = 1 pint

feet

a customary unit used to measure length
(1 foot= 12 inches)

foot

a customary unit used to measure length
(1 foot= 12 inches)

gallon

a customary unit used to measure liquid
capacity, 1 gallon=16 cups

gram	a metric unit used to measure mass- 1,000 grams= 1 kilogram
inch	a customary unit of length (12 inches= 1 foot)
kilogram	a metric unit used to measure mass (1 kilogram= 1,000 grams)
kilometer	a metric unit used to measure length or distance (1 kilometer= 1,000 meters)
liter	a metric unit used to measure capacity (1 liter= 1,000 milliliters)

meter	a metric unit used to measure length (1 meter= 100 centimeters)
meter	an instrument for measuring and sometimes recording the time or amount of something
mile	a customary unit used to measure length or distance (1 mile = 5280 feet)
millimeter	a metric unit used to measure length (1,000 millimeters = 1 meter)
ounce	a customary unit used to measure weight (16 ounces= 1 pound)

pint	a customary unit used to measure liquid capacity (2 pints = 1 quart)
pound	a customary unit used to measure weight (1 pound= 16 ounces)
quart	a customary unit used to measure liquid capacity (1 quart = 4 cups)
tablespoon	a customary unit of capacity (1 tablespoon = 3 teaspoons)
teaspoon	a customary unit of capacity equal to $\frac{1}{3}$ tablespoon

yard

a customary unit used to measure length or distance (1 yard = 3 feet)

kilogram

the basic unit of mass in the metric system that is nearly equal to the mass of 1000 cubic centimeters of water at its highest density
