approximate	nearly correct or exact
capacity	the volume of a container measured in liquid units
conversion	the process or act of converting, or changing from one form or function to another
convert	to alter, change, or exchange
customary	commonly practiced, used, or observed
degree	a unit of measure for angles or temperature
estimation	the act of estimating something, or the value, amount, or size arrived at in an estimate
exact	exhibiting or marked by strict, particular, and complete accordance with fact or a standard
height	the length of a segment from one vertex of a polygon perpendicular to the base
lengths	the longer or longest dimension of an object
mass	the amount of matter in an object
metric	of, relating to, or using the metric system: a system of measurement that uses meters to measure length, liters to measure capacity, and kilograms to measure mass
quantity	the amount or number of something
scale	a device that is used for weighing people or things
scale	numbers that show the units used on a graph
scale	anything graduated, especially when employed as a measure or rule, or marked by lines at regular intervals
sketches	to make a quick rough drawing of something
unit	a particular amount of length, time, money, etc., that is used as a standard for counting or measuring
volume	the number of cubic units in a three-dimensional figure
