

adjacent

having a common endpoint or border

adjustment

the act or process of adjusting, or
adapting to new conditions

amendment

the act of amending or correcting, or the
result of amending

arrangement

the state of being arranged, or put into
some kind of order

congruent

describing figures that have the same
shape and size

equivalent

numbers that name the same amount

event

a collection of one or more outcomes

experiment

a test/trial, or better known as an operation or procedure carried out under controlled conditions in order to discover an unknown effect or law, to test or establish a hypothesis, or to illustrate a known law

exponent

the number in a power that tells how many times a factor is repeated

frequent

happening at short intervals: often repeated or occurring

government

the act or process of governing;
specifically: authoritative direction or
control

installment

one of the parts into which a debt is
divided when payment is made at
intervals

measurement

the act or process of measuring

percent

a ratio in which the first term is
compared to 100

quotient

the answer in a division problem (for
example in, $35/7= 5$, 5 is the quotient

represent

to act or speak officially for something

resident

someone who lives in a particular place

segment

a portion cut off from a geometric figure by one or more points, lines, or planes: as the finite part of a line between two points in the line (line segment)

statement

something that you say or write in a formal or official way: something that is stated

tournament

a sports competition or series of contests that involves many players or teams and usually continues for a few days
