<b>Word</b>	<b>Definition</b>
<b>bile</b>	<b>a digestive juice that breaks down fats in the small intestine</b>
<b>exhale</b>	<b>to breathe out</b>
<b>fertile</b>	<b>being able to support growth and development; soil can be fertile if it will support the growth of plants</b>
<b>insoluble</b>	<b>not capable of being dissolved</b>
<b>malleable</b>	<b>capable of being rolled or pounded into flat sheets</b>
<b>mantle</b>	<b>the solid rock material between Earth's core and crust</b>
<b>marble</b>	<b>a metamorphic rock formed when limestone is subjected to heat and pressure</b>
<b>molecule</b>	<b>a particle that contains two or more atoms joined together</b>
<b>organelle</b>	<b>a specialized cellular part (as a mitochondrion, lysosome, or ribosome) that is analogous to an organ because it performs a particular function</b>
<b>particle</b>	<b>a very small piece or part</b>
<b>pole</b>	<b>either of the two ends of a magnet, where the magnetic force is strongest</b>
<b>predictable</b>	<b>able to estimate a future event based on data or experience</b>
<b>recycle</b>	<b>to use again</b>
<b>reliable</b>	<b>fit to be trusted; dependable</b>
<b>repeatable</b>	<b>able or fit to be repeated</b>
<b>sample</b>	<b>a part or thing that shows the quality of the whole or group</b>
<b>shale</b>	<b>a rock with a fine grain formed from clay, mud, or silt</b>
<b>soluble</b>	<b>capable of being dissolved</b>
<b>testable</b>	<b>capable of being tested or proved</b>
<b>variable</b>	<b>anything you can change in an experiment that might affect the outcome</b>
